Subject: 2017 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

On July 26, 2017 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:10 p.m., the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer a webcast, **2017 Professional Ethics and Conduct**, exclusively for State government employees. This course will satisfy the State CPA Board's annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 08G.0410 Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE]. The registration fee is \$50.00 per attendee.
