SUBJECT: Procurement Card Rebates and Federal Remittance Responsibilities

Recently agencies and universities received the 2008 rebate for the use of procurement cards provided under the State's contract with the Bank of America (for the fiscal period September 1- August 31). The policy and procedure for agencies to process procurement card rebates is located on OSC's website at: http://www.ncosc.net/sigdocs/sig_docs/documentation/policies_procedures/RebatePP.pdf.

Noteworthy mandates of the procurement card policy and procedure include:

- Rebates shall be deposited to the budget code from which the original expenditure was made
 using the specific revenue account established in the Statewide Chart of Accounts.
- The federal government must be allocated their portion of any rebate received.

The federal portion is based on the participation by the federal government in the particular program that generated the rebate. Each agency and university will be responsible for calculating the federal share of the rebate received. The federal portion will be remitted by agencies and universities to OSC which shall remit the fund share to the federal government.
